



RURAL MATH INNOVATION NETWORK

The Rural Math Innovation Network (RMIN) is an Investing in Innovation (i3) project funded by the U.S. Department of Education because of its potential to support workforce development for students, schools and communities across rural America. A total of 40 innovation-minded pre-Algebra and Algebra 1 teachers are being selected for the four-year RMIN project. The teachers will work in a virtual network to create lessons that increase student motivation for mastery of math skills and concepts needed for pursuing STEM and health postsecondary technician programs and career credentials. Participation is **limited to 2 teachers for up to 20 of the eligible rural school divisions** listed below. The superintendent or designee of interested school divisions should plan to participate in one of the two webinars below that will outline how to nominate teachers for the RMIN. Assistant superintendents and instructional leaders are also welcome to join either webinar.
